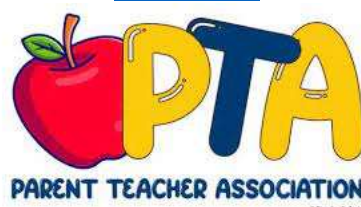

SENDLO – Website Update



The Local Authority have launched a new website for Wirral's Local Offer of SEND Services called 'SENDLO.' SENDLO brings together information about the local services and support available across education, health and social care for families with children and young people aged 0 to 25, who have special educational needs and/ or disabilities.

As part of the launch of the new Local Offer website SENDLO, Wirral SEND are hosting an event that will help really bring SENDLO to life and signpost families to what is on offer in Wirral. The aim is that parents and carers will leave better informed, supported and be confident that they have a go to place for answers and/or signposting. SENDLO Live will take place on **23rd November from 1pm-8pm at the Floral Pavilion, New Brighton.**

There will be a massive marketplace of services across Health, Education and Social Care. Third sector organisations will also be playing a key role in the day with Parent/Carer volunteers on hand to engage with families.

There will also be live dance performances from our SEND young people, workshops, demos, opportunities to 'have your say' and lots more. There will also be a sensory room for visitors who may find the noise, lighting, number of people a tad overwhelming.
