# **Sun Cream and Sun Hats**

As the weather has finally started to improve it is important that children have sun cream and sun hats in school with them. We have very little shade on the field / playground and if your child does not have a hat or suncream in school with them we may not be able to allow them to go out onto the playground / field on sunny days.

Please note, children must apply their own suncream when they are in school, thank you.



### Year 3 /4 Trip to World Museum, Liverpool

On Friday 10th May, Year 3/4 are going to the Liverpool World Museum. This is to enhance the children's learning of our current topic - Ancient Egypt. Each class will be taking part in a workshop at the museum, 'Meeting a Mummy' as well as visiting the Ancient Egypt Exhibition that is currently being run at the museum.

We are asking for a contribution of £10.50 per child. Please pay through school Gateway App.

As we will be having lunch off site, all children will need to bring a packed lunch (nut-free due to allergies) in a bag that can be thrown in the bin (not a lunchbox). We are also asking that the children bring in a water bottle that can be thrown away/recycled.

Children are not to bring their own money, as there will be no opportunity to visit the gift shop.



Unfortunately, due to low ticket sales the PTA 'Not So Serious Music Quiz Night' has been cancelled.


The next PTA event will be the Summer Fair on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> June.
